6 General Jackson wins Battle of New Orleans, two weeks after Treaty of Ghent signed (January 1815).

2 General Hull surrenders Fort Detroit to British (August 1812).

3 Commodore Perry wins naval battle and control of Lake Erie, forcing British from Detroit (September 1813).

4 Americans turn back British invading forces at Battle of Lake Champlain (summer, 1814).

5 British capture and burn parts of Washington, D.C. (August 1814). Americans defend Fort McHenry from British attack (August 1814).

1 British set up blockade of American ports (1812).
